- * Adding passing and climbing lanes
- * Improving intersections
- * Replacing culverts throughout the corridor
- * Constructing a bridge over the North Fork Anchor River
- * Replacing the bridge over the South Fork Anchor River
- * Increasing the shoulder width
- * Clearing vegetation
